Malted and roast barley, oats, chocolate malt, a handful of hops and a wee bit of fresh root ginger.

Summer session cider comprised of Scottish apples. Seriously awesome. Go on, you's earned it!

## Bubbly:

**Prosecco: Beletti**, Italy (11% ABV) bottle £16.00

Soft and fruity, peach and pear, breezy apple peel and lemon zest. Go on, celebrate.

## White

**Sauvignon Blanc: Andara**, Valle Central, Chile (12.5% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Refreshing and crisp with intense aromas of grapefruit, passion fruit and citrus.

**Chardonnay: Kooliburra Reserve**, South Eastern Australia (13% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Peach and melon fruit characters are joined by ripe tropical fruit flavours.

## Rose

**Rose: Toro Loco**, Valencia, Spain (12% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Aromas of raspberry and cherry, hints of citrus. Fresh and lively.

## Red

**Merlot: Andara**, Valle Central, Chile (13% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Soft, supple, and fruit driven, with intense aromas of plum, black cherries, chocolate and mint.

**Tempranillo: / Bobal, Toro Loco**, Valencia, Spain (12.5% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Full bodied and full of life. A blend of Bobal and Tempranillo grapes. Just right.

**Shiraz: Kooliburra Reserve**, Southeastern Australia (14% ABV) glass £4.00 / bottle £14.00

Rich black cherry and ripe berry, subtle black pepper, spice and soft oak characters.

**Appassimento: The Fire Tree**, Sicily, Italy (14.5% ABV) glass £4.50 / bottle £16.00

Red mature fruit aromas, plum and cherry flavours. Smooth and succulent finish. Yum.

# Single Malt Whiskies

## Highlands

**Aberlour (10 year):** Aberlour (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Golden amber with a slight reddish hue

**Nose:** Sweet and full. Sherried raisins, hints of toffee, and a pleasant nuttiness

**Taste:** Quite full-bodied, spicy rich fruitcake, toffee notes and a creamy malty-feel and the vaguest whisper of something akin to synthetic banana

**Finish:** Caramel and honey, the malt still evident and the sweet spices still linger

**Aberlour (12 year):** Aberlour (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.75

**Colour:** Golden amber with hints of ruby

**Nose:** Soft and rounded with fruity notes no red apple

**Taste:** A fine sherried character, balanced with rich chocolate, toffee, cinnamon, and ginger spices

**Finish:** Warming and lingering - sweet and slightly spicy

**The Ardmore:** Kennethmont, Aberdeenshire (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Light golden

**Nose:** Heather Honey with hints of cinnamon and toffee bonbon.

**Taste:** Creamy vanilla spice gives way to more overt smoky charcoal notes, especially with the addition of water. Smoke doesn't dominate and is balanced by the sweet honey and spice flavours.

**Finish:** Full bodied, silky mouth feel with a dry, tangy and lingering aftertaste, coupled with delicious spice notes.

**Dalmore (12 year):** Alness, (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £5.50

**Colour:** Rich amber

**Nose:** A warm coffee house in Seattle; roasting beans, the oily nuttiness in a fine espresso, there are little notes of malt and cereal and butter from the pastry counter with rich orange from the fruit bowl on the counter.

**Taste:** Notes of Seville marmalade and triple sec with winter spices and fruitcake. Zesty cocoa and milk chocolate.

**Finish:** Medium, oranges

**Glenmorangie (10 year):** Coy Tain, Ross-shire (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Yellow gold

**Nose:** A rich nose, flower and spicy hints with some vanilla wood notes

**Taste:** The taste confirms the nose, delicate honey wood taste with a subtle hint of nuttiness

**Finish:** Smooth and relatively long

**Old Pulteney (12 year):** Wick, (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Deep amber, red golden (with a slight pink hue) sparkling with a copper glow

**Nose:** Medium to high intensity with a briny hint of sea air

**Taste:** Dry, medium, and smooth, redolent of honey and cream, faintly salty with a slight spicy note

**Finish:** Sweet and long-lasting



**Tomatin Legacy (10 year):** (35ml measure, 43% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Pale gold

**Nose:** Lemon, panetella, and pine forest. Slightly green with vanilla.

**Taste:** Light and sweet with sweet barley and pine needles, grass, sweet honey candies, toffee, fruitcake, vanilla, white chocolate, oak, lemon, nuts, cinnamon, pepper

**Finish:** Smooth and relatively long

## Islands

**Highland Park (12 year):** Kirkwall, Orkney (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.50

**Colour:** Glowing amber.

**Nose:** Heather-honey sweetness; peaty smokiness

**Taste:** Rounded smoky sweetness; full malt delivery

**Finish:** Teasing, heathery, delicious

**Jura Origin (10 year):** Isle of Jura (35ml measure, 43% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Light golden, yellow.

**Nose:** Light clean and fresh, with a hint sea salt. Almonds, and spice notes.

**Taste:** Light peaty notes, with fruit and spicy overtones.

**Finish:** Sweet, peaty.

**Jura Superstition:** Isle of Jura (35ml measure, 43% ABV) £4.75

**Colour:** Golden with an amber tint

**Nose:** Light delicate phenolic aromas, with strong honey, spice, and cinnamon overtones

**Taste:** Add a little water and the delicate peat smoke will fill your mouth, mixed with the honey and spices

**Finish:** Long lasting balanced finish

**Jura Prophecy:** Isle of Jura (35ml measure, 43% ABV) £5.95

**Colour:** Golden with an amber tint

**Nose:** Some peat, aniseed, fry, pungent, oily

**Taste:** Smoky and dry, a muscular, powerful Jura with notes of nutmeg, cardamom, sea spray. Coal Tar.

**Finish:** Good length, with punch, dry peat smoke and herbal notes.

**Ledaig (10 year):** Tobermory, Isle of Mull (35ml measure, 46.3% ABV) £4.75

**Colour:** Delicate lemon yellow

**Nose:** Quite light and well balanced. There is a very soft peat with a gentle smoke. Notes of barley and malt extract with walnut and pine oil and a hint of iodine with notes of dried fruits and nuts.

**Taste:** Medium-bodied and quite rich. There are notes of spice and smoke gathering above the charred oak. The peat is quiet and dry with a touch of black pepper and earth.

**Finish:** Medium-length and slightly smoky with spice.

**Talisker Skye:** Isle of Skye (35ml measure, 45.8% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Bright autumnal gold

**Nose:** Sweet stuff, toffees and vanilla ice cream up front, almost grain-like. Becomes increasingly honeyed. There's a little coastal influence here too, just hints of sweet Caol Ila perhaps, with very restrained smoke

**Taste:** Honeyed toasted oak, sappy wood, only a little pepper and smoke, apple turnovers and hints of lemon and lime Opal Fruits. Fennel seeds

**Finish:** Drying and slightly less sweet, hints of spice and smoke

**Talisker Storm:** Isle of Skye (35ml measure, 45.8% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Bright autumnal gold

**Nose:** Initial brine, but not as abrupt as the 10 Year Old, quite creamy by comparison. Banana. Banana angel delight? Window putty, hint of sticking plasters and barbecues, citrus. White pepper develops towards the bottom of the glass.

**Taste:** Thick and mouth-coating with wood smoke, brine, some tin and chilli heat too.

**Finish:** Red chilli peppers and oak dryness with a hint of embers.

## Islay

**Bunnahabhain (12 year):** Bunnahabhain (35ml measure, 46.3% ABV) £4.75

**Colour:** Deep gold

**Nose:** Full, refined and rich with oily peat hints, toffee, liquorice and flowers

**Taste:** Rather intense but still sweet with some peat hints, a rather rustic but still delicate taste

**Finish:** A pleasant long full finish, coming back on ripe fruit and honey

**Laphroaig (10 Year)** (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.50

**Colour:** Full sparkling gold

**Nose:** Huge smoke, seaweedy, "medicinal," with a hint of sweetness.

**Taste:** Surprising sweetness with hints of salt and layers of peatiness.

**Finish:** Lingerin'.

**Laphroaig Select** (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Sparkling gold

**Nose:** Classic, medicinal peat notes up front, supported by citrus-y, chocolaty sweet notes and soft barley

**Taste:** The peat is there, but it's taking it easy and letting the bright notes of lemon, green apples and mint stand out. Darker baking spice notes develop further on

**Finish:** Medium length, peat remaining in sight until it's over

## Speyside

**Auchentoshan American Oak:** Lowlands (35ml measure, 40%ABV) £4.50

**Colour:** Bright gold

**Nose:** Bourbon vanilla and coconut layers of zesty citrus fruit

**Taste:** Refreshingly smooth yet lively with vanilla cream, coconut, and white peach

**Finish:** Crisp with sugared grapefruit and a hint of spice

**The Balvenie Doublewood (12 year):** Dufftown (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £5.00

**Colour:** Honey caramel

**Nose:** Gristy, supple nuttiness intertwined with spices. Honeyed sultanas and grapes. Hugely inviting.

**Taste:** Sweet with good body. The bourbon characters; gentle spice with a little vanilla, a hint of balancing peat lurking quietly in substrata. Dried fruit, too, combining with nuts, nutmeg, cinnamon, nack into the bourbon notes- so well integrated.

**Finish:** Spicy, slightly drying, still sweet.

**Glenfiddich (12 year):** Dufftown (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Golden

**Nose:** Fresh and fragrant, touch of pear

**Taste:** Distinctive, well-balanced flavour of rich fruit, subtle pine and a hint of peatiness

**Finish:** Satisfyingly long, lingering and rounded and smooth aftertaste

**Glenfiddich IPA:** Dufftown (35ml measure, 43% ABV) £6.50

**Colour:** Rich Golden

**Nose:** An elegant harmony of fresh green apple, William's pear and spring blossom. Complimented with Aromatic hops and fresh herbs.

**Taste:** Vibrant with a zesty citrus note followed by creamy vanilla and a hint of fresh hops.

**Finish:** Enduring sweetness with an echo of green hops.

**The Glenlivet Founder's Reserve:** Banffshire (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Some dates then what at first appears to be a touch of salinity, but it is better described as a slightly sharp plum and apricot wine note. There's orange zest, toffee, hints of struck match and chocolate raisins, but before this starts to sound "Sherried," there's also pear drops, a dusting of sweet cinnamon, honeysuckle and sweet pea

**Nose:** Fruity, then sweet, more toffee, a touch of anise, then into milk chocolate Flakes, banoffee pie and apple turnovers

**Taste:** Subtle peatiness. Delicate. Slightly sweet and fruity, with vanilla notes. Clean and well-balanced

**Finish:** Creamy toffee to the fore now, a little oak and sweet barley sugar warmth, too. Milk chocolate raisins linger

**The Glenlivet (12 year):** Banffshire (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Light or pale gold

**Nose:** Aromatic, with flowers. Clean and simple, with some maltiness. Sherry notes, some spice and vanilla

**Taste:** Subtle peatiness. Delicate. Slightly sweet and fruity, with vanilla notes. Clean and well-balanced

**Finish:** Long, but mild and warming. A trace of peat at the end

**Glen Moray:** Elgin (35ml measure, 40% ABV) £4.25

**Colour:** Mid-golden

**Nose:** Sweet, fruity and floral. Highland toffee and candy floss with honeycomb and sweet malt notes

**Taste:** Butterscotch candies, golden barley and a touch of cinnamon. The port cask influence comes

through with light notes of raisins and freshly picked red berries.

**Finish:** Rather long, with honey, vanilla and a dusting of cocoa.

**Glen Moray Port Cask:** Elgin (35ml measure, 40% ABV)

**Colour:** distinct pink hue

**Nose:** Creamy vanilla at the fore, joined by jammy red currants and blackberry. Toasted oak.

**Taste:** Smooth, warming and rounded with a good firm body. Lots of sweet, soft malty flavours evolve in the centre of the palate, surrounded by toffee and mouth watering fruits

**Finish:** Toffee, blackcurrants and a hint of liquorice remains into the finish which is medium in length

**The Singleton of Auchroisk (12 year):** Dufftown, Banffshire

**Nose:** Smooth, sweet, sherry and malty. Slight hint of peat
